Dear Parents/Carers and Year 11 students,

Further to my email this morning following recent government announcements regarding how GCSEs grades will be awarded this year, we wanted to confirm our plans for results day:

- Results day will go ahead as planned on Thursday 20 August.
- Students are invited to attend our academy during their designated time slot to receive their results - which will be a certificate of Centre Assessed Grades (CAGs).
- Our Senior Leadership Team will be available throughout the morning to assist you with any queries relating to their CAG results or Post-16 progression.
- Students that do not attend the academy to pick up results will have their certificate of CAGs emailed out after 2pm on Thursday 20 August.

Next week, students will receive their moderated formal grades that have been referred to as 'official' grades by email. The vast majority of these grades are expected to be the same as the CAGs unless the moderated grades see any increase as part of that process.

Please may I remind you that to reduce any risk associated with COVID-19 that students attend their designated time slot only, and if they wish to be supported when collecting their CAGs, that only one immediate family member is present. We ask that if your child or any family members are displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or are in a quarantine period, that you do not attend our academy and request alternative communication for your child's CAG results.

Our finance team will be on hand to return locker deposits. Please note you will not be able to access the school building to empty any belongings and alternative arrangements will need to be made. We would be grateful if any calculators or revision guides can also be returned on Thursday.

I thank you for your continued support during these continuing unprecedented times and I am looking forward to seeing as many of our class of 2020 on Thursday.
